- Do not use the tricycle on roads, driveways, or any area with moving vehicles.
- Do not let other children push the tricycle while your child is seated.
- Always exercise caution to prevent accidents or collisions.
- Regularly check and tighten all screws and parts to ensure safety and proper functioning.

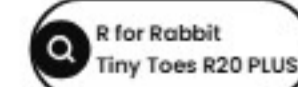

## Installation Steps

### Step 1:

Attach the rear wheels to each side of the main frame body.



### Step 2:

Position the mudguard over the front wheel with pedals.



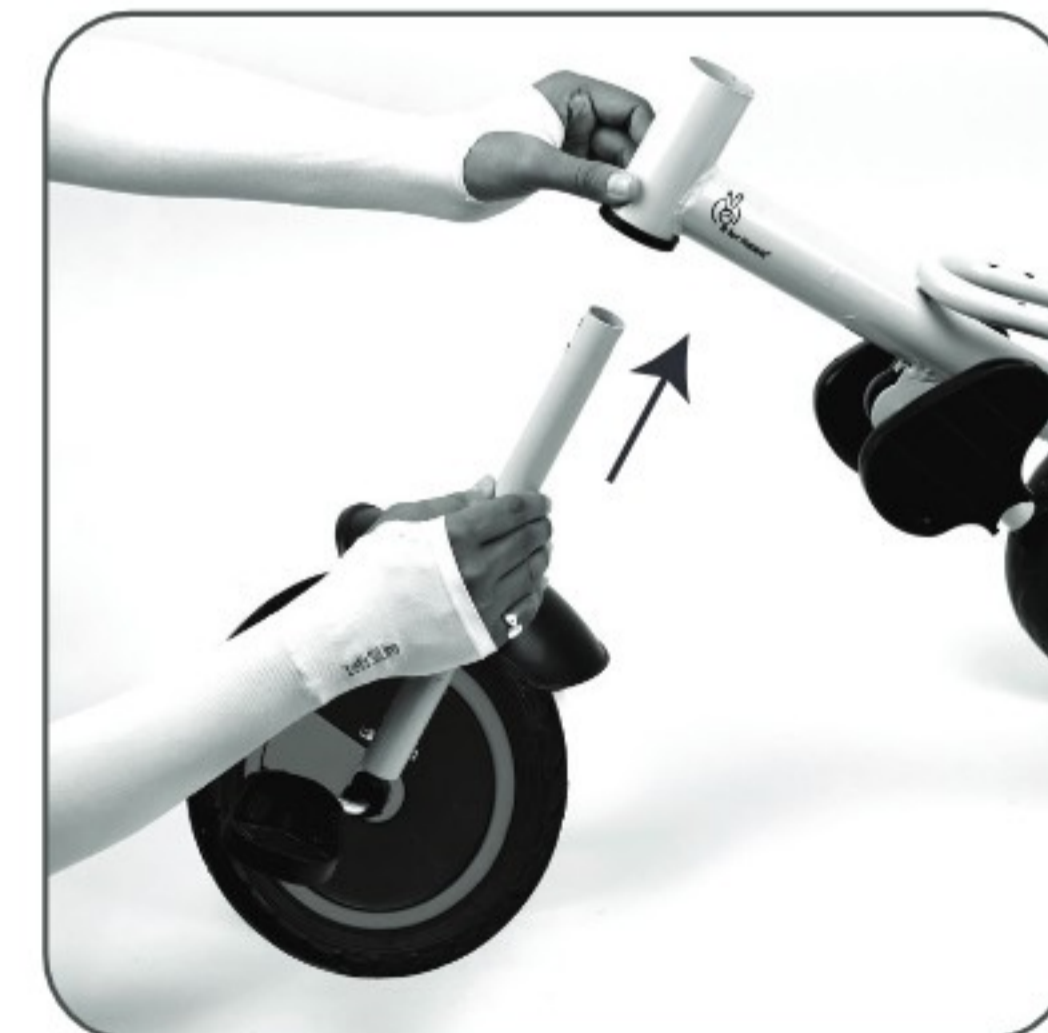
### Step 3:

Remove the cap from the frame body.



### Step 4:

Fix the front wheel with pedals to the frame body.



**Step 5:**  
Install the front basket by securing it in place.



**Step 6:**  
Press the push pin and slide the handlebar into position until it clicks.



**Step 7:**  
Tighten the handlebar screw to secure it.



**Step 8:**  
Press push pin and unfold the leg stand as demonstrated.



**Step 9:**  
Unscrew and remove the circular rubber part from the rear axle.



**Step 10:**  
Remove the screw on top of the rear axle.



**Step 11:**  
Insert the rear axle under the frame body. Press the push pin until it clicks.



**Step 12:**  
Slide the rubber part back on the rear axle and tighten with the screw.



**Step 13:**

Place the cap with screw on top of the rear axle.



**Step 14:**

Attach the hook end of the steering rod into the hole as shown in image.



**Step 17:**

Attach the parental handle to the rear axle until it clicks and tighten the screw.



**Step 18:**

Fix the bottle holder onto the parental handle.



**Step 15:**

Secure the rear axle with screw as shown in image.



**Step 16:**

Position the seat on the frame and secure it using screws.



**Step 19:**

Attach the rear basket using screws.



**Step 20:**

Your Tiny Toes R20 Plus tricycle is now ready for use!
